

# POKER GENERAL ROOM RULES

High Card ▶ One Pair ▶ Two Pairs ▶ Three of a Kind ▶ Straight ▶ Flush  
Full House ▶ Four of a Kind ▶ Straight Flush ▶ Royal Flush

1. CARDS SPEAK: The winner of any called or checked hand must expose all their cards prior to the pot being awarded. Cards read for themselves. Dealers will assist in the reading of hands to the best of their ability but it is the player's responsibility to protect his/her hand at all times.
2. ENGLISH ONLY WHILE THE CARDS ARE IN PLAY.
3. It is the player's responsibility to protect their hand at all times. A player who fails to take reasonable means to protect their hand shall have no redress if their hand becomes fouled or the dealer accidentally collects the hand.
4. If a player wants to contest a pot, the player must do so immediately. Once the dealer presses the green button on the shuffler or deals out the cards for the next hand, all rights to the previous hand have been lost.
5. Electronic devices may be used while a player is seated at any of the poker tables; such as, but not limited to: cell phones, PDAs, I-Pods, head phones, or Bluetooth ear pieces. Talking/texting while in a hand is prohibited. Please note that any violations to this rule will disqualify (kill) the player's hand and money will not be refunded.
6. Foreign objects such as napkins, pocket books, etc. will not be allowed to be placed on any poker table.
7. Hoods, hats, or sunglasses may be worn at the poker table, however upon leaving the table, hoods or anything that covers the player's face must be removed.
8. Players are not allowed to communicate information about their hand to other players. This will result in both players' hands being disqualified (killed). Excessive violation of this rule will have the player(s) in question removed from the table and/or the poker room.
9. All players are responsible for making the best hand possible out of his/her cards and presenting their hand to the dealer face up, for review.
10. An incorrect amount of cards to any player may constitute a misdeal.
11. When calling a bet, it is the player's responsibility to determine the correct amount of an opponent's bet before calling, regardless of what is stated by others.
12. Tie hands split the pot.
13. An exposed card does not constitute a misdeal.
14. Players are not allowed to have side bets against each other.
15. Each betting round shall consist of (1) bet and/or (3) raises maximum in limit games. In no-limit games, unlimited raises are permitted.
16. Players may not change from one table to another without the consent of poker personnel.
17. In a new game, players who arrive at the table earliest get first choice of remaining seats. If multiple players want the same seat and arrive at the same time, the player that is higher on the list will have preference.
18. Players may not remove chips from the table except when quitting the game or paying for "incidentals" i.e. tips, food, cigarettes etc.
19. If a player returns to the same game within one hour of cashing out, the buy-in must equal the amount removed from the table. (For PLO games, the wait time must be two hours)
20. Passing chips between players is not allowed on any poker table.
21. A player has the right to an unimpeded view of an opponent's chips, when requested.
22. If a player taps the table or in any way indicates he/she passes it is considered a check.
23. If a player leaves the game for more than two absent buttons or 30 minutes, their chips will be picked up and the player will be put on the bottom of the player waiting list.
24. ALLOWABLE WAGERS/BETS:
  - a. All wagers shall be made with gaming chips.
  - b. It is the player's responsibility to protect his hand, chips, and valuables.
  - c. A short bet or call in which chips have been released may either be completed or forfeited.
25. STRING BETS are not allowed. If a bettor intends to raise, he should either put all the chips on the table at one time or announce that he is intending to raise.
26. Supervisors have the right to stop any player from drinking alcohol if they feel that the customer has had too much to drink.
27. Stalling, colluding or any other suspicious activity found to obtain a promotion in a dishonest manner is subject to disqualification at management's discretion.
28. HOUSE RAKE: The rake schedule is as follows:

Pot	Jackpot	House
\$1-\$14	\$4	\$1
\$15-\$24	\$4	\$2
\$25-\$34	\$4	\$3
\$35-\$44	\$4	\$4
\$45-\$54	\$4	\$5
\$55 and up	\$4	\$6

- In the case of no flop, there will be no drop taken.
- All bomb pot or hands that are ran twice will have a standard jackpot rake of \$10 and \$12 house fee regardless of the pot amount.
- Subject to vary on bonus promotional days.
  - On "Bonus", Super Bonus, or "Crazy" high hand days, an additional \$1-\$3 will be taken for the jackpot promotional fund as dictated in the monthly rules.

# SEVEN CARD GAMES JACKPOT RULES

## (Texas Hold'em & Seven Card Stud)

1. A **Royal Flush** is defined as the Ten, Jack, Queen, King and Ace of the same suit.
2. Texas Hold'em players must use both cards in their hand to win. Players must use the best five card combination to win.
3. Seven card players must use two 'hole cards' and three face up cards to win.
4. All Jackpot drop boxes will be collected and counted by treasury on a daily basis with the funds being added to the Promotional Cash Fund.
5. All promotional payouts will be paid in chips or cash as documented on the payout form.
6. **The Royal Flush jackpot payout amount is as follows:**

Suit	Amount
<b>Royal in Spades (AK)</b>	<b>\$25,000</b>
<b>Royal in Diamonds (AK)</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
<b>Royal in Hearts (AK)</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
<b>Royal in Clubs (AK)</b>	<b>\$1,000</b>
<b>Any other Royal combination</b>	<b>\$500</b>

- a. In order to obtain Royal Flush in Spades, a player must contain the "A" and "K" spades in their hand to qualify.
    - i. Any other two cards will obtain a set amount of **\$500**.
  - b. Royal Flush in Diamonds, Hearts and Clubs, a player must contain the "A" and "K" suited in their hand to qualify.
    - i. Any other two cards will obtain a set amount of **\$500**.
7. Royal Flush prizes will be displayed with the indicated amounts above.
  8. Advertised promotional funds may be transferred to other promotions at any time.
    - a. Spades Royal Flush jackpot excess funds will fund new promotions
    - b. All other suits will stop accumulating and begin at base amount once hit.
  9. Promotion being funded by transferred funds will be noted in said rules.
  10. Once the royal flush jackpot is obtained, it will start back at the base amount.
  11. High Hand Promotion (Texas Hold'em & Seven Card) qualify. Texas Hold'em players must use one-hole card and play the best five. Stud players must use 2 hole cards and 3 up cards, no ties, once a hand is established it will take a higher hand to win.
  12. High hand promotions do qualify in the instances that the board is ran "multiple times" but do not qualify for the Royal Flush Progressive.
    - a. Note: High hands obtained on the flop from the secondary board are still only subject to 50%.
  13. Single and multi-table tournaments will qualify for eligible promotions except for all royal flush jackpots except when otherwise noted.
    - a. For single table tournament, a designated portion of the per buy-in money will be dropped for the benefit of the jackpot. The amounts are as follows: \$5.00/\$10.00 for Texas Hold'em.
  14. The house must verify all jackpot hands before the jackpot can be paid. This includes number of burn cards, proper dealing techniques, deck verification, etc.
  15. Any jackpot and/or prize won or obtained by illegal means, cheating, use of cheating devices, collusion, Theft, fraud, or scam to defraud the enterprise will not be honored. The violator(s) will be subject to criminal prosecution.
  16. Patrons must present the Micosukee M Sphere card in order to receive the prize.
  17. Players intentionally attempting to alter the outcome of this promotion may be disqualified or asked to leave.
  18. Players must be at least 18 years of age to participate.
  19. Must have valid, Government issued, gaming approved ID to claim the prize. Prize will be retained for 30 days if valid, Government issued, gaming approved ID is not provided at the time of win.
  20. For games requiring an ante, it will be an amount determined by the players.
    - a. Please note that not all games offered require a player ante.
  21. For all seven card games, a \$4 jackpot rake will be taken per hand.
    - a. An additional \$2 will be collected when running it twice.
  22. House Rake: The house will collect 10% of the pot: a minimum of \$1.00 and a maximum of \$6.00 per hand.
    - a. When running it twice, an additional \$1.00 will be collected.
  23. Micosukee Reserves the right to modify or cancel a promotion at any time.

Management decisions are final.

# EIGHT OR NINE CARD GAMES JACKPOT RULES

1. A **Royal Flush** is defined as the Ten, Jack, Queen, King, and Ace of the same suit.
2. A Jackpot prize will go to the person who holds two cards in their hand, of the same suit along with the "three" cards on the "flop" that would constitute that particular Royal Flush of that particular suit.
3. All Jackpot drop boxes will be collected and counted by treasury on a daily basis with the funds being added to the Promotional Cash Fund.
4. All promotional payouts will be paid in chips or cash as documented on the payout form.
5. **The Royal Flush jackpot amount is as follows:**

Suit	Amount
<b>Royal in Any Suit (AK)</b>	<b>\$20,000 on Flop</b>

- a. In order to obtain the Royal flush jackpot, a player must contain the "A" and "K" of any suit in their hand to qualify. Any other combination will not qualify.
6. Royal Flush prizes will be displayed with the indicated amounts above.
  7. A Royal Flush attained by any other two cards will not qualify for any prize payout amount.
  8. Advertised promotional funds may be transferred to other promotions at any time.
    - a. Royal Flush jackpot excess funds will fund new promotions
  9. Promotion being funded by transferred funds will be noted in said rules.
  10. Once the royal flush jackpot is obtained, it will start back at the base amount.
  11. Once the royal flush jackpot is obtained, it will start back at the base amount.
  12. All 8-9 Card games must "flop" their High Hand and play the best five card combination in order to obtain 100% of the promotional amount.
  13. High hand promotions do qualify in the instances that the board is ran "multiple times" but do not qualify for the Royal Flush Progressive.
    - a. Note: High hands obtained on the flop from the secondary board are still only subject to 50%.
  14. Single and multi-table tournaments will qualify for eligible promotions except for all royal flush jackpots except when otherwise noted.
    - a. For single table tournament, a designated portion of the per buy-in money will be dropped for the benefit of the jackpot. The amounts are as follows: \$5.00/\$10.00.
  15. All jackpots obtained must be verified by the house before the jackpot can be paid. This includes number of burn cards, proper dealing techniques, deck verification, and count etc.
  16. Any jackpot and/or prize won or obtained by illegal means, cheating, or use of cheating devices, collusion theft, fraud, or scam to defraud the enterprise will not be honored. The violator(s) will be subject to criminal prosecution.
  17. Patrons must present their M Sphere Rewards card to receive the prize.
  18. Players intentionally attempting to alter the outcome of this promotion may be disqualified or asked to leave.
  19. Players must be at least 18 years of age to participate.
  20. Must have a valid government-issued, gaming-approved ID to claim the prize. The prize will be retained for 30 days if a valid, government-issued, gaming-approved ID is not provided at the time of the win.
  21. For games requiring an ante, it will be an amount determined by the players.
    - a. Please note that not all games offered require a player ante.
  22. For each Omaha, Tahoe, or pineapple game, a \$4 jackpot rake will be taken per hand.
    - a. When running it twice, an additional \$2.00 will be collected.
  23. House Rake: The house will collect 10% of the pot: a minimum of \$1.00 and a maximum of \$6.00 per hand.
    - a. When running it twice, an additional \$1.00 will be collected.
  24. Micosukee reserves the right to modify or cancel the promotion at any time.
